4. **HAWISE le STRANGE**; m. Sir Robert de Felton of Litcham, Norfolk, cr. Lord Felton, 1312, slain at Bannockburn, 24 June 1314. (*CP V*, 289-290).

5. **SIR JOHN de FELTON** of Litcham, Lord Felton, knighted 13 Nov. 1310, Admiral of England, 1325, d. bef. 1346; m. Sibyl. (*CP V*, 290-291).

6. **SIR THOMAS de FELTON, K.G.**, of Litcham, 2nd son, Inq.p.m. 25 May 1381; m. Joan. (*CP V*, 292 note *e*).

7. **ELEANOR de FELTON**; m. (1) **SIR ROBERT de UFFORD**, Lord Clavering (49A-7); m. (2) in or bef. Feb. 1394/5, as his 1st wife, Sir Thomas Hoo of Luton-Hoo, co. Bedford, fought at Agincourt. (*CP V*, 294; VI, 561).

8. **SIR THOMAS HOO, K.G.**, d.s.p.m. 13 Feb. 1454/5, cr. Lord Hoo of Hoo, co. Bedford, 1448; m. (1) Elizabeth, dau. of Nicholas Wychingham of Wychingham, Norfolk. (*CP VI*, 561-564).

9. **ANNE HOO**, ae. 30+ in 1454/5; m. Sir Geoffrey Boleyn, Lord Mayor of London, 1457, d. 1463. (*CP VI*, 565; X, 137, note *b*; XII (2), 739; *DNB II*: 783).

10. **SIR WILLIAM BOLEYN, K.B.**, of Blicking, Norfolk; m. **MARGARET BUTLER** (17-11), dau. of **SIR THOMAS BUTLER** (17-10), 7th Earl of Ormond, by his 1st wife, **ANNE** (17B-20), dau. of Sir Richard Hankeford. (*CP X*, 137, note *b*; XII (2), 739; *DNB II*: 783).

6. **RALPH de CROMWELL**, of Cromwell and West Hallam, d. bef. 28 Oct. 1364; m. 1351, Amice, dau. of Roger de Bellers.

7. **RALPH de CROMWELL**, Lord Cromwell of Tattershall, co. Lincoln, M.P., 1375-1397, d. 27 Aug. 1398; m. bef. 20 June 1366, **MAUD BERNAKE** (132-8), d. 10 Apr. 1419. (Generations 3 to 7: *CP III*, 551-552; V, 519).

1. **ALAN of GALLOWAY**, Named in the Magna Charta, 1215, Constable of Scotland, 1215-1234, Lord of Galloway, d. 1234; m. (1) N.N., dau. or sis. of Roger de Lacy, of Pontefract, Constable of Chester (*Tr. Dumfrieshire and Galloway Natural History Society* 49: 49-55); m. (2) 1209, Margaret de Huntingdon, dau. of David of Huntingdon (son of Henry of Huntingdon and grandson of David I "The Saint," King of Scots) and Maud of Chester. (*SP IV*, 138-143).

2. **HELEN of GALLOWAY** (by the first wife), d. aft. 21 Nov. 1245; m. **ROGER de QUINCY** (74-2, 88-2). (*CP XII* (2), 751).
